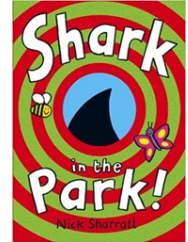


## Phonics Activities

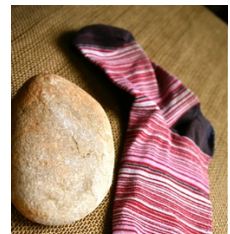
- Listen to environmental sounds e.g. birds, cars



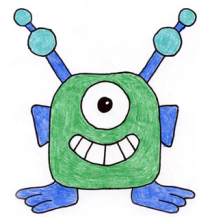
- Read rhyming stories e.g. Shark in the Park, Hairy Maclary, Each Peach Pear Plum



- Find rhyming pairs using pictures or objects e.g. egg and peg/ sock and rock/ jelly and welly



- Draw aliens and create nonsense names beginning with the same sound e.g. Zilly Zolly Zee!



- Play 'I spy' using letter sounds e.g. I spy with my little eye something beginning with sss...sun



- Explore voice sounds. Make animal sounds (e.g. baa for sheep) and try using different voices for characters in stories (e.g. loud shouting for a giant)



- Practise oral blending and segmenting. Call instructions, then child to blend sounds and do actions e.g. adult: touch your n-o-se, child: nose! Next, try swapping roles.
